Phoning NHS 111 Wales



When you phone you will hear recorded voice messages.

Listen carefully.

Choose the options that are best for you.



A call handler will ask questions to find out what help you need.

They might be able to give you the right help.



You might need to talk to someone else.

You might talk to

- A nurse
- A dental nurse
- Health Information staff

If it is busy, they might need to phone you back later.



They might tell you how you can look after yourself.

They might tell you to go to see a pharmacist.



If your problem is more serious, they might tell you

- to go to see a doctor
- or to go to the hospital



If your problem is very serious, NHS 111 Wales can call an ambulance for you.



You can also phone 111 if you need your doctor but your doctors surgery is closed.
